Name 1 medical system barrier and 1 cultural/social barrier patients and caregivers facing stage IV cancers experience.

- What can your institution do to lower/remove such barriers?

Name 2 ways pain is uniquely endured and 2 ways it is potentially managed by people with stage IV cancers.

- How might your institution improve pain management for advanced cancers, across Rx and other palliative methods?

Name 2 ways the "structural competency" of cancer care providers can influence quality of care. ([structuralcompetency.org](http://structuralcompetency.org), e.g., ways you think SC could influence oncology pain management, healthcare affordability, or policy factors affecting equity of living and working environments for cancer patients).

- What is 1 action step you can take to improve your own structural competency as a provider, moving forward?
